

Isaiah 14:12-14 Verse 12 How have you fallen from heaven, O light-bringer and daystar, son of the morning! How you have been cut down to the ground, you who weakened and laid low the nations [O blasphemous, satanic king of Babylon!]

13 And you said in your heart, I will ascend to heaven; I will exalt my throne above the stars of God; I will sit upon the mount of assembly in the uttermost north.

14 I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will make myself like the Most High.

2 Corinthians 11:2 I feel a divine jealousy for you, for I betrothed you to Christ to present you as a pure bride to her one husband.

Isaiah 14:15-17 Yet you shall be brought down to Sheol (Hades), to the innermost recesses of the pit (the region of the dead).

16 Those who see you will gaze at you and consider you, saying, Is this the man who made the earth tremble, who shook kingdoms?—

17 Who made the world like a wilderness and overthrew its cities, who would not permit his prisoners to return home?

Genesis 11:1-9 Verse 1 And the whole earth was of one language and of one accent and mode of expression.

Verse 2 And as they journeyed eastward, they found a plain (valley) in the land of Shinar, and they settled and dwelt there.

Verse 3 And they said one to another, Come, let us make bricks and burn them thoroughly. So they had brick for stone, and slime (bitumen) for mortar.

Verse 4 And they said, Come, let us build us a city and a tower whose top reaches into the sky, and let us make a name for ourselves, lest we be scattered over the whole earth.

Verse 5 And the Lord came down to see the city and the tower which the sons of men had built.

Verse 6 And the Lord said, Behold, they are one people and they have all one language; and this is only the beginning of what they will do, and now nothing they have imagined they can do will be impossible for them.

Verse 7 Come, let Us go down and there confound (mix up, confuse) their language, that they may not understand one another's speech.

Verse 8 So the Lord scattered them abroad from that place upon the face of the whole earth, and they gave up building the city.

Verse 9 Therefore the name of it was called Babel, because there the Lord confounded the language of all the earth; and from that place the Lord scattered them abroad upon the face of the whole earth.

John 14:6 Jesus said to him, I am the pathway, the Way and the Truth and the Life; no one comes to the Father except by (through) Me.

John 1:14-18 So the word of God became a human being and lived among us. We saw his splendour (the splendour as of a father's only son), full of grace and truth. And it was about him that John stood up and testified, exclaiming: "Here is the one I was speaking about when I said that although he would come after me he would always be in front of me; for he existed before I was born!" Indeed, every one of us has shared in his riches—there is a grace in our lives because of his grace. For while the Law was given by Moses, love and truth came through Jesus Christ. It is true that no one has ever seen God at any time. Yet the divine and only Son, who lives in the closest intimacy with the Father, has made him known.

Galatians 5:22-25 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, **23** gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law. **24** And those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires.

25 If we live by the Spirit, let us also keep in step with the Spirit.

Ephesians 3:17-19 "May Christ through your faith [actually] dwell (settle down, abide, make His permanent home) in your hearts! May you be rooted deep in love and founded securely on love,"

"[That you may really come] to know [practically, through experience for yourselves] the love of Christ, which far surpasses mere knowledge; that you may be filled [through all your being] unto all the fullness of God [may have the richest measure of the divine Presence; and become a body wholly filled and flooded with God Himself]!

Read Isaiah 28:10 For precept must be upon precept, precept upon precept; line upon line, line upon line; here a little, and there a little:

From the spirit we receive

1. Spirit sight

2 Corinthians 3:18 And we all, with unveiled face, beholding the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from one degree of glory to another. For this comes from the Lord who is the Spirit.

2. Spirit hearing

Acts 2:2 And suddenly there came a sound from heaven, as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting. The sound from heaven is

the hearing of the spirit, faith comes by hearing and spiritual hearing comes by the word of God.

3. Spirit aroma

2 Corinthians 2:15 For we are the aroma of Christ, the aroma of grace to God among those who are being saved and among those who are perishing,

4. Spirit taste

Psalms 34:8 Oh, taste and see that the LORD is good; Blessed is the man who trusts in Him! Trusting in the LORD is tasting of the Lord.

5. Spirit touch

John 20:27 He drew close to Thomas. Jesus: Reach out and touch Me. See the punctures in My hands; reach out your hand, and put it to My side; leave behind your faithlessness, and believe, spirit touch, grasp Christ by faith and bring the power of grace into my life and the lives of others.

Isaiah 55:8-9 For My thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways My ways, says the Lord.

9 For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are My ways higher than your ways and My thoughts than your thoughts.

Matthew 26:41 Watch and pray so that you will not fall into temptation. The spirit is willing, but the flesh is weak.
