

**Deuteronomy 30:19** “I call heaven and earth to record this day against you, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing: therefore choose life, that both thou and thy seed may live:”

**John 14:5-6** Thomas said to Him, “Lord, we do not know where You are going, and how can we know the way?”

Jesus said to him, “I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.

**Genesis 3:2-3** the woman said to the serpent, We may eat the fruit from the trees of the garden, but of the fruit of the tree which *is* in the midst of the garden, God has said, ‘You shall not eat it, nor shall you touch it, lest you die.’

**Genesis 3:4-5** Then the serpent said to the woman, “You will not surely die. For God knows that in the day you eat of it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil.”

**1 Peter 5:8** Be sober [well balanced and self-disciplined], be alert *and* cautious at all times. That enemy of yours, the devil, prowls around like a roaring lion [fiercely hungry], seeking someone to devour.

**Romans 5:12** Therefore, just as through one man sin entered the world, and death through sin, and thus death spread to all men, because all sinned.

**Mark 12:30-31** Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength.’ The second is this: ‘Love your neighbor as yourself.’ There is no commandment greater than these

Except the fruit from the tree which is in the middle of the garden. God has said, You shall not eat of it, neither shall you touch it, lest you die.

**Ephesians 2:6** And has raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus:

**2 Timothy 1:7** For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.

**1 Corinthians 2:16** For “who has known the mind of the LORD that he may instruct Him?” But we have the mind of Christ.

**Colossians 3:17** Whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks through Him to God the Father.

**John 15:1** I am the true vine, and my Father is the husbandman.

**Galatians 5:22-23** But the Holy Spirit produces this kind of fruit in our lives: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. There is no law against these things!

**Romans 8:1-2** *There is* therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who<sup>[a]</sup> do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit. 2 For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death.

**Ephesians 2:2** in which you once walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit who now works in the sons of disobedience.

**Isaiah 55:8** “For My thoughts are not your thoughts, Nor are your ways My ways,” says the LORD.

**Ephesians 5:26** That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word,

**1 Cor 3:6** I have planted, Apollos watered; but God gave the increase.

**Mark 4:13-20** And He said to them,

(S1) “Do you not understand this parable? How then will you understand all the parables?”

14 (S2) The sower sows the word.

15 (S3) And these are the ones by the wayside where the word is sown. When they hear, Satan comes immediately and takes away the word that was sown in their hearts.

16 These likewise are the ones sown on stony ground who, when they hear the word, immediately receive it with gladness;

17 **(S4)** and they have no root in themselves, and so endure only for a time. Afterward, when tribulation or persecution arises for the word's sake, immediately they stumble.

18 Now these are the ones sown among thorns; they are the ones who hear the word,

19 **(S5)** and the cares of this world, the deceitfulness of riches, and the desires for other things entering in choke the word, and it becomes unfruitful.

20 But these are the ones sown on good ground, those who hear the word, accept it, and bear fruit: some thirtyfold, some sixty, and some a hundred."

**John 5:2-15** Now there is at Jerusalem by the sheep market a pool, which is called in the Hebrew tongue Bethesda, having five porches.

**3** In these lay a great multitude of impotent folk, of blind, halt, withered, waiting for the moving of the water.

**4** For an angel went down at a certain season into the pool, and troubled the water: whosoever then first after the troubling of the water stepped in was made whole of whatsoever disease he had.

**5** And a certain man was there, which had an infirmity thirty and eight years.

**6** When Jesus saw him lie, and knew that he had been now a long time in that case, he said to him, Will you be made whole?

**7** The impotent man answered him, Sir, I have no man, when the water is troubled, to put me into the pool: but while I am coming, another steps down before me.

**8** Jesus said to him, Rise, take up your bed, and walk.

**9** And immediately the man was made whole, and took up his bed, and walked: and on the same day was the sabbath.

**10** The Jews therefore said unto him that was cured, It is the sabbath day: it is not lawful for thee to carry your bed.

**11** He answered them, He that made me whole, the same said to me, Take up your bed, and walk.

**12** Then asked they him, What man is that which said to you, Take up your bed, and walk?

**13** And he that was healed knew not who it was: for Jesus had conveyed himself away, a multitude being in that place.

**14** Afterward Jesus findeth him in the temple, and said to him, Behold, you are made whole: sin no more, lest a worse thing come to you.

**15** The man departed, and told the Jews that it was Jesus, which had made him whole.

**John 16:33** “I told you these things so that you can have peace in me. In this world you will have trouble, but be brave! I have defeated the world.”

**Mark 7:13** making the word of God of no effect through your tradition which you have handed down. And many such things you do.”

**1 John 4:18** There is no fear in love [dread does not exist]. But perfect (complete, full-grown) love drives out fear, because fear involves [the expectation of divine] punishment, so the one who is afraid [of God’s judgment] is not perfected in love [has not grown into a sufficient understanding of God’s love].
