

John 10:10 The thief comes only in order to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have life, and have it in abundance [to the full, till it overflows].

Mark 4:2 And he taught them many things by parables, and said unto them in his doctrine. "Listen! Behold, a sower went out to sow.

Philippians 3:10 That I may know him, and the power of his resurrection, and the fellowship of his sufferings, being made conformable unto his death;

Romans 10:9 Because if you acknowledge *and* confess with your lips that Jesus is Lord and in your heart believe (adhere to, trust in, and rely on the truth) that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.

Mark 4:26-27 " He also said, 'This is what the Kingdom of God is like. A man scatters seed on the ground. Night and day, whether he sleeps or gets up, the seed sprouts and grows, though he does not know how.'

1 John 1:5 This is the message [of God's promised revelation] which we have heard from Him and now announce to you, that God is Light [He is holy, His message is truthful, He is perfect in righteousness], and in Him there is no darkness at all [no sin, no wickedness, no imperfection].

1 Thessalonians 5:5 for you are all sons of light and sons of day. We do not belong to the night nor to darkness.

Matthew 13:24-30 Jesus gave them another parable [to consider], saying, "The kingdom of heaven is like a man who sowed good seed in his field. 25 But while his men were sleeping, his enemy came and sowed weeds [resembling wheat] among the wheat, and went away. 26 So when the plants sprouted and formed grain, the weeds appeared also. 27 The servants of the owner came to him and said,

'Sir, did you not sow good seed in your field? Then how does it have weeds in it?' 28 He replied to them, 'An enemy has done this.' The servants asked him, 'Then do you want us to go and pull them out?' 29 But he said, 'No; because as you pull out the weeds, you may uproot the wheat with them. 30 Let them grow together until the harvest; and at harvest time I will tell the reapers, "First gather the weeds and tie them in bundles to be burned; but gather the wheat into my barn.'"

Hebrews 4:12 For the word of God is living and active *and* full of power [making it operative, energizing, and effective]. It is sharper than any two-edged sword, penetrating as far as the division of the soul and spirit.

Galatians 6:8 For the one who sows to his flesh [his sinful capacity, his worldliness, his disgraceful impulses] will reap from the flesh ruin *and* destruction, but the one who sows to the Spirit will from the Spirit reap eternal life.

Genesis 8:22 While the earth remains, Seedtime and harvest, Cold and heat, Winter and summer, And day and night Shall not cease.”

Matthew 12:37 For by your words [reflecting your spiritual condition, your heart speaking my words] you will be justified and acquitted of the guilt of sin; and by your words [rejecting Me, speaking opposite to my words] you will be condemned and sentenced.”

Ecclesiastes 12:14 “ For God will bring every deed into judgment, including every hidden thing, whether it is good or evil. “

Genesis 2:7 Then the Lord God formed man from the dust of the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath *or* spirit of life, and man became a living being.
