**2 Corinthians 4:4** Satan, who is the god of this world, has blinded the minds of those who don't believe. They are unable to see the glorious light of the Good News. They don't understand this message about the glory of Christ, who is the exact likeness of God.

John 8:42-47 "If God were really your Father," replied Jesus, "you would have loved me. For I came from God, and I am here. I did not come of my own accord—he sent me, and I am here. Why do you not understand my words? It is because you cannot hear what I am really saying. Your father is the devil, and what you are wanting to do is what your father longs to do. He always was a murderer, and has never dealt with the truth, since the truth will have nothing to do with him.

Whenever he tells a lie, he speaks in character, for he is a liar and the father of lies. And it is because I speak the truth that you will not believe me. Which of you can prove me guilty of sin? If I am speaking the truth, why is it that you do not believe me? The man who is born of God can hear these words of God and the reason why you cannot hear the words of God is simply this, that you are not the sons of God."

**1 Corinthians 10:13** No temptation has overtaken you except what is common to mankind. And God is faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted,he will also provide a way out so that you can endure it.

**John 14:6** Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.

**John 3:3** Jesus replied, "Very truly I tell you, no one can see the kingdom of God unless they are born again."

Romans 10:9-10 If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved. And the Truth Jesus Christ will make us free

**Matthew 16:13-19** Now when Jesus went into the region of Caesarea Philippi, He asked His disciples, "Who do people say that the Son of Man is?"

- **14** And they answered, "Some say John the Baptist; others, Elijah; and still others, Jeremiah, or [just] one of the prophets."
- **15** He said to them, "But who do you say that I am?"
- **16** Simon Peter replied, "You are the Christ (the Messiah, the Anointed), the Son of the living God."

**Galatians 3:24** So that the Law served to us Jews] as our trainer [our guardian, our guide to Christ, to lead us] until Christ [came], that we might be justified (declared righteous, put in right standing with God) by and through faith.

- **25** But now that the faith has come, we are no longer under a trainer (the guardian of our childhood).
- 26 For in Christ Jesus you are all sons of God through faith.
- **27** For as many [of you] as were baptized into Christ [into a spiritual union and communion with Christ, the Anointed One, the Messiah] have put on (clothed yourselves with) Christ.

- **28** There is [now no distinction] neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is not male and female; for you are all one in Christ Jesus.
- **29** And if you belong to Christ [are in Him Who is Abraham's Seed], then you are Abraham's offspring and [spiritual] heirs according to promise.
- **17** Then Jesus answered him, "Blessed [happy, spiritually secure, favored by God] are you, Simon son of Jonah, because flesh and blood (mortal man) did not reveal this to you, but My Father who is in heaven.
- **18** And I say to you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build My church; and the gates of Hades (death) will not overpower it [by preventing the resurrection of the Christ].
- **19** I will give you the keys (authority) of the kingdom of heaven; and whatever you bind [forbid, declare to be improper and unlawful] on earth will have [already] been bound in heaven, and whatever you loose [permit, declare lawful] on earth will have [already] been loosed in heaven."

Depression spirit bind, loose the Spirit of joy and praise

**Isaiah 61:3** To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness, that they might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that He might be glorified

- **Matthew 16:21-23** From that time on Jesus began to show His disciples [clearly] that He must go to Jerusalem, and endure many things at the hands of the elders and the chief priests and scribes (Sanhedrin, Jewish High Court), and be killed, and be raised [from death to life] on the third day.
- **22** Peter took Him aside [to speak to Him privately] and began to reprimand Him, saying, "May God forbid it! This will never happen to You."
- 23 But Jesus turned and said to Peter, "Get behind Me, Satan! You are a stumbling block to Me; for you are not setting your mind on things of God, but on things of man."
- **Acts 8:9** Now there was a man named Simon, who previously practiced magic in the city and amazed the people of Samaria, claiming to be someone great.
- **10** They all paid [a great deal of] attention to him, from the least to the greatest, saying, "This man is what is called the Great Power of God!"
- **11** They were paying attention to him because for a long time he had mystified and dazzled them with his magic.

- **12** But when they believed Philip as he preached the good news about the kingdom of God and the name of Jesus Christ, they were being baptized, both men and women.
- **13** Even Simon believed [Philip's message of salvation]; and after being baptized, he continued on with Philip, and as he watched the attesting signs and great miracles taking place, he was constantly amazed.
- **14** When the apostles in Jerusalem heard that [the people of] Samaria had accepted the word of God, they sent Peter and John to them.
- 15 They came down and prayed for them that they might receive the Holy Spirit;
- **16** for He had not yet fallen on any of them; they had simply been baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus [as His possession].
- **17** Then Peter and John laid their hands on them [one by one], and they received the Holy Spirit.
- **18** Now when Simon saw that the Spirit was given through the laying on of the apostles' hands, he offered them money,
- **19** saying, "Give me this authority and power too, so that anyone on whom I lay my hands may receive the Holy Spirit."
- **ACTS 8:20** But Peter said to him, "May your money be destroyed along with you, because you thought you could buy the [free] gift of God with money!
- **21** You have no part or share in this matter, because your heart (motive, purpose) is not right before God.
- **22** So repent of this wickedness of yours, and pray to the Lord that, if possible, this thought of your heart may be forgiven you.
- 23 For I see that you are [a]provoked by bitterness and bound by sin."
- **24** But Simon answered, "Pray to the Lord for me both of you, so that nothing of what you have said will come upon me."
- **Galatians 2:7** But on the contrary, when they saw that the gospel for the uncircumcised [GENTILES] had been committed to me [PAUL], as the gospel for the circumcised [JEWS] was to Peter
- **8** For He who worked effectually in Peter for the apostleship to the circumcised [JEWS] also worked effectively in me toward the Gentiles)
- **1 Peter 1:1** Peter, an apostle of Jesus Christ, to God's elect, exiles scattered throughout the provinces of Pontus, Galatia, Cappadocia, Asia and Bithynia,
- **2** who have been chosen according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, through the sanctifying work of the Spirit, to be obedient to Jesus Christ and sprinkled with his blood:

Grace and peace be yours in abundance.

**Revelation. 3:9** "Behold, I will make them of the synagogue of Satan, which say they are Jews, and are not, but do LIE; behold, I will make them to come and worship before thy feet".

**Revelation 18:20** "Rejoice over her, O heaven! Rejoice, saints and apostles and prophets! God has judged her ["Babylon the Great" -- Rome and the Catholic Church] for the way she treated you). May God speed that day!

Revelation 18:23 For by your sorceries were all nations deceived

**John 15:26** But when the Comforter (Counselor, Helper, Advocate, Intercessor, Strengthener, Standby) comes, Whom I will send to you from the Father, the Spirit of Truth Who comes (proceeds) from the Father, He [Himself] will testify regarding Me.

**Jude 1:20** But you, beloved, build yourselves up [founded] on your most holy faith make progress, rise like an edifice higher and higher], praying in the Holy Spirit;

**Romans 8:27** And He Who searches the hearts of men knows what is in the mind of the [Holy] Spirit [what His intent is], because the Spirit intercedes *and* pleads [before God] in behalf of the saints according to *and* in harmony with God's will.

**Galatians 5:16** But I say, walk *and* live [habitually] in the [Holy] Spirit [responsive to *and* controlled *and* guided by the Spirit]; then you will certainly not gratify the cravings *and* desires of the flesh (of human nature without God).

**17** For the desires of the flesh are opposed to the [Holy] Spirit, and the [desires of the] Spirit are opposed to the flesh (godless human nature); for these are antagonistic to each other [continually withstanding and in conflict with each other], so that you are not free *but* are prevented from doing what you desire to do.

**18** But if you are guided (led) by the [Holy] Spirit, you are not subject to the Law. and produces His fruit in those yielded to Him

**Galatians 5:22** But the fruit of the [Holy] Spirit [the work which His presence within accomplishes] is love, joy (gladness), peace, patience (an even temper, forbearance), kindness, goodness (benevolence), faithfulness,

**23** Gentleness (meekness, humility), self-control (self-restraint, continence). Against such things there is no law [that can bring a charge].

**Galatians 5:25** If we live by the [Holy] Spirit, let us also walk by the Spirit. [If by the Holy Spirit we have our life in God, let us go forward [b]walking in line, our conduct controlled by the Spirit.]

Romans 8:14. For all who are led by the Spirit of God are sons (and daughters) of God.

**John 3:6** What is born of [from] the flesh is flesh [of the physical is physical]; and what is born of the Spirit is spirit.

**2 Corinthians 11:4** For [you seem readily to endure it] if a man comes and preaches another Jesus than the One we preached, or if you receive a different spirit from the [Spirit] you [once] received or a different gospel from the one you [then] received *and* welcomed; you tolerate [all that] well enough!
