

1 John 1:5 This is the message [of God's promised revelation] which we have heard from Him and now announce to you, that God is Light [He is holy, His message is truthful, He is perfect in righteousness], and in Him there is no darkness at all [no sin, no wickedness, no imperfection].

Jeremiah 32:41 I will rejoice over them to do them good, and I will faithfully plant them in this land with all My heart and with all My soul.

Genesis 6:6 The LORD was very sad that he had made man on the earth. His heart was filled with pain.

John 8:44 You are of *your* father the devil, and it is your will to practice the desires [which are characteristic] of your father. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth because there is no truth in him. When he lies, he speaks what is natural to him, for he is a liar and the father of lies *and* half-truths.

1 John 3:8 The one who practices sin [separating himself from God, and offending Him by acts of disobedience, indifference, or rebellion] is of the devil [and takes his inner character and moral values from him, not God]; for the devil has sinned *and* violated God's law from the beginning. The Son of God appeared for this purpose, to destroy the works of the devil.

John 13:16 When the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you into all truth. He will not speak on his own but will tell you what he has heard. He will tell you about the future.

Luke 10:19 Listen carefully: I have given you authority [that you now possess] to tread on serpents and scorpions, and [the ability to exercise authority] over all the power of the enemy (Satan); and nothing will [in any way] harm you.

Matthew 8:28 When they arrived on the other side of the lake, in the region of the Gadarenes, two demonized men confronted Jesus. They lived among the tombs of a cemetery and were considered so extremely violent that no one felt safe passing through that area.

Matthew 8:29 The demons screamed at Jesus, shouting, "Son of God, what do you want with us? Leave us alone! Have you come to torment us before the appointed time?"

Matthew 8:30-31 There was a large herd of pigs feeding nearby. And the demons pleaded, "If you cast us out, send us into that herd of pigs."

Matthew 8:32 Jesus commanded, "Then go!" And at once the demons came out of the men and went into the pigs. Then the entire herd of crazed pigs stampeded down the steep slope and fell into the water and drowned.

Matthew 8:33-34 The men who were herding the pigs fled to the nearby town and informed the people of all that had happened to the demonized men. Then everyone from the town went out to confront Jesus and urged him to go away and leave them alone.

Ephesians 2:10 We have become his workmanship, a re-created people that will fulfill the destiny he has given each of us, for we are joined to Jesus, the Anointed One. Even before we were born, God planned in advance our destiny and the good works we would do to fulfill it!

1 Timothy 4:2 Those teachings come through people who tell lies and trick others. These evil people cannot see what is right and what is wrong. It is like their conscience has been destroyed with a hot iron.

Matthew 9:38 So pray to the Lord of the harvest to send out workers into His harvest.

Psalms 9:4-5 For You have maintained my just cause;
You have sat on the throne judging righteously.
You have rebuked the nations, You have destroyed the wicked;
You have blotted out their name forever and ever.
But whilst we are here on earth and up until the Judgement seat, God never gives up on us, He continually calls us throughout our time to come into Him.

2 Thessalonians 2:14 To this he called you through our gospel, so that you may obtain the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Ephesians 2:11-12 So don't forget that you were not born as Jews and were uncircumcised (circumcision itself is just a work of man's hands); you had none of the Jewish covenants and laws; you were foreigners to Israel's incredible heritage; you were without the covenants and prophetic promises of the Messiah, the promised hope, and without God.

Ephesians 2:13 *Yet look at you now! Everything is new!* Although you were once distant and far away from God, now you have been brought delightfully close to him through the sacred blood of Jesus—you have actually been united to Christ!

Ephesians 2:14 Our reconciling “Peace” is Jesus! He has made Jew and non-Jew one *in Christ*. *By dying as our sacrifice*, he has broken down every wall of prejudice that separated us *and has now made us equal through our union with Christ*.

Ephesians 2:15 Ethnic hatred has been dissolved by the crucifixion of his precious body on the cross. The legal code that stood condemning every one of us has now been repealed *by his command*. His triune essence has made peace between us by starting over—forming one new race of humanity, Jews and non-Jews fused together in himself!

Ephesians 2:16 Two have now become one, and we live restored to God and reconciled in the body of Christ. Through his crucifixion, hatred died.

Ephesians 2:17 For the Messiah has come to preach this sweet message of peace to you, the ones who were distant, and to those who are near.

Ephesians 2:22 So you are no longer outsiders or aliens, but fellow-citizens with every other Christian—you belong now to the household of God. Firmly beneath you in the foundation, God’s messengers and prophets, the actual foundation-stone being Truth, Jesus Christ himself. In him each separate piece of building, properly fitting into its neighbour, grows together into a temple consecrated to God. You are all part of this building in which God himself lives by His spirit.
