

Proverbs 25:26 When a lover of God gives in and compromises with wickedness (in an unrenewed mind), it can be compared to contaminating a stream with sewage or polluting a fountain.

Romans 6:6 Could it be any clearer that our former identity is now and forever deprived of its power? For we were co-crucified with him to dismantle the stronghold of sin within us, so that we would not continue to live one moment longer submitted to sin's power.

Philippians 2:4-5 Abandon every display of selfishness. Possess a greater concern for what matters to others instead of your own interests. And consider the example that Jesus, the Anointed One, has set before us. Let his mindset become your motivation.

Luke 22:10:13 Jesus gave them this sign:

This is Jesus word seed with faith sown into the disciples

“When you enter the city, you will find a man carrying a jug of water. Follow him home and say to the owner of the house,

Then Jesus tells them to repeat the word seed faith instruction.

‘The Teacher told us to ask you, “Where is the room I may use to have the Passover meal with my disciples?” ’

Now faith moves in action to fulfill the word seeds directive.

He will then take you to a large, fully furnished upstairs room. Make the preparations for us there.

Then they receive their faith seed harvest.

” They went and found everything to be exactly like Jesus had prophesied, and they prepared the Passover meal.

1 Corinthians 3:6 I planted, Apollos watered; but God gave the increase.

Romans 10:17 So then, faith comes from what is heard, and what is heard comes through the word of Christ.

James 2:22 “You see, his faith and his actions worked together. His actions made his faith complete.”

Mark 2:1-4 A few days later, when Jesus again entered Capernaum, the people heard that he had come home. They gathered in such large numbers that there was no room left, not even outside the door, and he preached the word to them. Some men came, bringing to him a paralyzed man, carried by four of them. Since they could not get him to Jesus because of the crowd, they made an opening in the roof above Jesus by digging through it and then lowered the mat the man was lying on.

Mark 2:5 When Jesus saw their faith, he said to the paralyzed man, “Son, your sins are forgiven.”

Romans 10:17 Faith, then, is birthed in a heart that responds to God’s anointed utterance of the Anointed One.

Matthew 4:4 He answered, “The Scriptures say: Bread alone will not satisfy, but true life is found in every word that constantly goes forth from God’s mouth.”

Phillipians 4:19 I am convinced that my God will fully satisfy every need you have, *for I have seen* the abundant riches of glory *revealed to me* through Jesus Christ!!

1 Peter 1:9 For you are reaping the harvest of your faith—the full salvation promised you—your souls’ victory, your salvation

Mark 4:14-20 Let me explain (Jesus is explaining, how the just shall live by faith)

The farmer sows the message of the kingdom.

God sows the word in us with faith, then we sow the word by speaking it.

What falls on the beaten path represents those who hear the message,

But the satan comes immediately to steal the Word

But immediately Satan appears and snatches it from their hearts.

If we resist satan then he works through the minds of those in the world and through my own natural thoughts, to come again to steal the word.

And what is sown on gravel represents those who hear the message and receive it joyfully, but because their hearts fail to sink a deep root, they don't endure for long. For when trouble or persecution comes on account of the message, they immediately wilt and fall away.

And what is sown among thorns represents those who hear the message, but they allow the cares of this life and the seduction of wealth and the desires for other things to crowd out and choke the message so that it produces nothing.

Then comes the end of your faith word

“But what is sown on good soil represents those who open their hearts to receive the message

The harvest, to give back to God, to glorify Him.

and their lives bear good fruit, some yield a harvest of thirty, sixty, even a hundredfold!”
